## Introduction of Japan's "Quality Infrastructure" in Senegal and Morocco "Quality Infrastructure Workshop"

The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism held "Quality Infrastructure Workshop" with the Republic of Senegal on November 27<sup>th</sup>, in preparation for "Senegal-Japan High Quality Infrastructure Conference" to be held in January next year. We also held "Quality Infrastructure Seminar" with the Kingdom of Morocco on November 30<sup>th</sup>.

We promoted the understanding of Japan's "Quality Infrastructure Investment," and presented the technologies and experiences of Japanese infrastructure-related companies.

For the preparation of “Senegal-Japan High Quality Infrastructure Conference” to be held in January next year, we also discussed the details of the program and the efforts to be made after the conference. Along with the workshop, we paid a courtesy call on Minister for Investment Promotion, Partnerships and Development of State Teleservices Mbaye, and explained Japan's efforts for “Quality Infrastructure Investment.”
